Will there be a ZΛ 646? Chartered in 1951, Sigma Nu has a long and storied history on the campus of the University of Tulsa. The chapter has initiated 645 men into the fraternity's ranks. However, in late 2004 facing a failed rush and issues with the University, Sigma Nu National made the hard decision to temporarily suspend chapter operations. Nationals suggested a four to five year timeline before reactivating the chapter to allow Zeta Lambda the opportunity at having a fresh and entirely new

Nationals has issued a letter of intent with the University to reactivate Zeta Lambda chapter. To reinforce National's efforts and to provide a framework for alumni support, a group of alumni have begun the process of establishing the Zeta Lambda Alumni Chapter. You will be hearing a great deal about both of these developments over the next few months.

The next step with the Univer-

sity is an IFC vote to clear the way for the reactivation process. That vote should take place sometime in September. Should IFC fail to clear the way, the process will open for other fraternities to "bid" for the open slot on campus. Given our strong alumni base and the temporary nature of Sigma Nu's absence from TU, we expect the IFC vote to go well.

This newsletter is the first attempt to reach a large group of our alumni. The second letter will most likely be sent out as soon as we hear the results of the IFC vote. * Brother Jake Dollarhide (ZA 591) is the co-founder and Chief Executive Officer of Longbow Asset Management Company in Tulsa, OK.


